MRI

While some MRI scans can be somewhat constricting due to the narrow area where the scan takes place, our short-length, wide bore MRI scanner is a very comfortable scanner, similar to a CT scanner. Our scanner offers very high image quality. We also let you select your own music for your scan to increase your comfort level even further. (No radiation is used with MRI scans.)

Please let us know if you have an aneurysm clip or any implantable electronic device in your body such as a cardiac pacemaker.

The benefits of the radiation used in medical imaging outweigh the risks, however, it is important to use the smallest amount of radiation possible while also delivering top-quality images. Our 64-slice CT scanner has technology installed that helps deliver up to 40% less radiation per dose than traditional CT scanners. We also use detailed protocols and other techniques to ensure your radiation dose is as small as possible.

If you are receiving IV contrast, do not eat any solid foods within 2 hours of your exam. If you are having an abdominal/pelvic exam, you may receive oral contrast.

Ultrasound

Ultrasound uses sound waves to create detailed images of the body, especially soft tissues. Our state-of-the-art equipment produces very clear 3D digital images. (No radiation is used with Ultrasound scans).

Abdomen: Please do not eat or drink anything 8 hours prior to your exam except for water and necessary medications. If you are also having a Pelvic Ultrasound, please follow the directions below.

Kidney & Pelvis: Please drink two 8 oz. glasses of water for a kidney exam 1 hour prior to your appointment or drink three 8 oz. glasses of water for a pelvis exam 1 hour prior to your appointment and keep your bladder full for your exam (this helps the sonographer better visualize the pelvic organs and bladder).

Pregnancy: For pregnancies in the first 14 weeks, please drink three 8 oz. glasses of water 1 hour prior to your appointment and keep your bladder full for your exam. For pregnancies after the first 14 weeks, it is not necessary to have a full bladder for your exam.

For your convenience, Swedish accepts most insurance plans. If you are unsure about your coverage, please contact your benefit administrator. We provide imaging services to the emergency department 24-hours a day, seven days a week. For outpatient services we offer convenient appointments, including same day scheduling for many exams.
